The Project

KAVI – Institute of Clinical Research (KAVI - ICR) is an institute of the University of Nairobi mandated to conduct innovative and impactful health research. KAVI – ICR conducts phase I to III clinical trials of drugs and potential vaccine candidates in HIV, Ebola, Tuberculosis, and other infectious diseases. The institute also conducts observational, epidemiological and implementation science research focusing on adolescents and young women health, reemerging pathogens and cancers.

Purpose of position

The Research Clinical Officer will conduct delegated study procedures including mobilization, recruitment, determining eligibility, enrolment and follow-up of study participants in accordance with study protocol, Good Clinical Practice (GCP) guidelines and the Protection of Human Subjects (HSP) guidelines.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Recruit, consent, screen, determine eligibility, and enrol eligible study participants into clinical studies.
- 2. Administer investigational products to eligible participants and follow them up for safety, efficacy and immunogenicity assessments per protocol
- 3. Collect data in study case report forms and data collection tools
- 4. Respond to data queries in a timely manner
- 5. Provide appropriate medical treatment and where necessary, facilitate referral of study participants with medical ailments and complications
- 6. Ensure retention of study participants in clinical studies
- 7. Elicit, report and manage serious adverse events (SAEs) as per protocol and site SOPs
- 8. Perform any other relevant clinical or research duties as assigned by the Clinic Manager, Principal Investigators or Director, KAVI ICR.

Job requirements/Specifications:

- 1. Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized university or college
- 2. Must be registered with the Clinical Officers Council (Kenya) and present a valid practicing license
- 3. Must have valid Good Clinical Practice and Human Subjects Protection Training certificates

- 4. Must have at least 3 years' prior experience conducting vaccine clinical trials
- 5. Experience and skills needed: qualitative and quantitative data collection skills, Quality Control and Quality Assurance skills, HIV counselling and testing, excellent written and verbal communication skills.

Terms of Appointment

This a one-year full time contract renewable based on performance and by mutual consent.
