STUDY NURSE (ANAEMIA STUDY), UNITID - AD/11/215/21 - 1 POST

The Position

Reporting to the Study Coordinator, the Study Nurse will be responsible for recruiting and enrolling participants into the study in Compliance with the study protocol. The position will be based at Kangemi Health Centre.

Responsibilities

- Screening, recruiting and enrolling participants to the study.
- Counselling the study participant on Artificial Family planning Methods including LIUS
- Identifying prior study participants to be enrolled in the study.
- Using WHO and study-specific criteria to screen participants for eligibility, including conducting pelvic exams for ruling out medical contraindications
- Helping Collect data per approved Standard Operating Procedures and input into Android tablet system (RedCap)
- Undertake HVS swabs for screening for GC and Chlamydia.
- Counsel women on HIV and prevention
- Collecting, preparing, and storing samples from study participants.
- Submit twice-weekly summaries of recruitment and enrollment into the study to the study coordinator.
- Participate in weekly phone call with PI and rest of study staff.
- Any other duties as may be assigned by the Principal Investigator

Required Academic Qualifications

1. Must be registered by the Nursing Council of Kenya
2. Must have a Diploma in Kenya Registered Nursing/Midwifery (KRN/M) or Kenya Registered Community Health Nursing (KRCHN)

Experience

1. At least one-year experience post-registration
2. Past research experience
3. Solid family planning counselling experience and proven ability to safely provide intrauterine contraception

Required Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

- Excellent computer skills (Attach computer training certificate)
- Excellent communication skills: Must be able to communicate to the study participants well and with PI via email and Zoom
- Excellent skills with mobile technology
- Language skills: fluency in English, Kiswahili
- Team player with ability to work closely with other study staff at the site
